I want a soccer ball, a scooter and a doll! And don't forget the bigger room down the hall!


Oh, yes, I need allowance, and can we have a pool? And maybe cooler tennis shoes like Danny takes to school....




Prayer is not a one-way street, but a time for God and us to meet. Here's a bet-ter

Help me to be kinder, to grow to be like you And help me to have love in all I say and do




